## Application Requirements

Applicants should:

- Be interested in U.S. and German foreign relations and transatlantic cooperation.
- Be between 18 to 30 years old.
- Be enrolled at a German university or undergo professional training (including apprenticeship etc.). We accept any degree program and academic level.
- Obtain the proper visa or travel authorization (e.g., ESTA) if applicable.
- Have or obtain international travel health insurance.

## How to apply

Please submit the following information:

1. **Your resume** (max. two pages)
2. **Answers to the following three questions** (max. 150 words for each question)
  - How would you benefit from attending the GAC 2023?
  - How would the GAC benefit from having you?
  - What is your transatlantic story, and why are you interested in transatlantic relationships?
3. **A short video** (max. two minutes) in which you briefly introduce yourself, illustrate your interest in transatlantic relations and your motivation to attend the GAC - be creative!

By applying you agree that the travel scholarship will be voided if the conference is canceled or held remotely. This also applies if government travel restrictions are imposed between the US and any affected countries. You agree, that your personal data is stored until October 31st, 2023.
